Details of Council Tax Support (CTS) caseloads, expenditure and break even point.

## North Northamptonshire – Break Even Point

- The harmonised percentage that would have no net impact on Council Tax income would be <u>24.9%</u>, based on <u>current</u> <u>caseloads</u>.
- Each 1% decrease from this break-even point would reduce Council Tax income by £110K.
- For example, setting the minimum payment at 20% would reduce income by around £538K.

## North Northamptonshire – Break Even Point

- The harmonised percentage that would have no net impact on Council Tax income would be <u>24.3%</u>, based on <u>Pre Covid-19</u> caseloads.
- Each 1% decrease from this break-even point would reduce Council Tax income by just over £95K.
- For example, setting the minimum payment at 20% would reduce income by around £407K.
